## CLUE 2

1. Do NOT open your blocks to square up. Try the method in the video to square your blocks to $91 / 2$ inches. (Half size: Square to $41 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ ) Squaring them before ironing open ensures that your triangle has the same amount of fabric on both sides so that your blocks match up easier when putting your quilt together. See video!!!!!
2. Note: Lisa is showing how to square these blocks using the "Clearly Perfect Slotted Trimmer" ruler. You can also use either a $91 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ or $41 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ Square ruler and use it like Lisa shows in the video. If you have none of these rules, you can tape off a $12^{\prime \prime}$ ruler to $91 / 2$ or $4 \frac{1}{2}$ " size shape square.
