Final Step!

Borders

- 1. Cut 8-6 inch strips across the width of fabric for your borders.
- 2. (Half size: cut 4 strips 2 ½" or 3" wide your choice)
 - a. I added an inner and outer border to my wall hanging.
 - b. Inner: Cut 4 strips WOF 2 1/2 "
 - c. Outer: Cut 4 strips WOF 3 1/2 "
- 3. Sew the strips together end to end and fit border to sides first; then top of quilt. If you don't want the 83x83 size quilt, then just bind the quilt without the borders for a smaller quilt.
- 4. Add as many or as few borders as you like to make the finished size of your choice.
- 5. Sandwich batting between top and backing . . . quilt and bind.

I hope you have enjoyed this 2022 Mystery Quilt project! I have enjoyed putting together my first instructions and video. Happy Quilting!!!!
