INITIAL CUTTING INSTRUCTIONS FOR 60 X 60 QUILT

<u>Pick instructions based on which fabric you're using either charm packs, fat quarters or scraps.</u>

<u>2 Charm Packs</u> – Organize the charm squares into 41 matching pairs. From each pair, reserve 1 square at 5x5. Subcut 2 squares 2 ½ by 2 ½ from the other 5" square.

<u>7 Fat Quarters</u> – Cut 2 strips 5x22 and subcut in 6 squares 5x5. Cut 2 strips 2 ½ x 22 and subcut into 12 squares 2 ½ x 2 ½. Organize your squares by print.

Scraps – Cut 41 sets with each set containing 1 square 5x5 and 2 squares $2 \frac{1}{2} \times 2 \frac{1}{2}$ of the same print.

Background Fabric – Cut 17 strips x WOF. Subcut into 2 ½ x 7 rectangles, 5 per strip, until you have 82 Cut 11 strips 2 ½ x 5 rectangles, 8 per strip until you have 82

NOTE: We will be using larger pieces of the background fabric in a future step.

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<u>Initial Cutting Instructions for</u> <u>Approx. 30 X 30 Wall QUILT</u>

<u>Pick instructions based on which fabric you're using either charm packs,</u> fat quarters or scraps.

(30 x 30 Cutting Instr. continued)

1 Charm Pack –

Option # 1: Choose 21 fabrics from pack. From each 5 x 5" square - Subcut 2 ea. 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ " square and 4 ea. 1 $\frac{1}{4}$ " squares. (This leaves you half of the pack for another project.

Option # 2: Use all colors in pack. From each 5" square subcut 1 ea. $1 \frac{1}{2}$ " square & 2ea. $1 \frac{1}{2}$ " squares. This option leaves you with scraps from each color.

<u>4 Fat Quarters</u> – Cut 2 strips 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 22 and subcut in 6 squares 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ ". Cut 2 strips 1 $\frac{1}{4}$ " x 22 and subcut into 12 squares 1 $\frac{1}{4}$ " x 1 $\frac{1}{4}$ ". Organize your squares by print.

Scraps – Cut 41 sets with each set containing 1 square $2 \frac{1}{2}$ x $2 \frac{1}{2}$ and 2 squares $1 \frac{1}{4}$ x $1 \frac{1}{4}$ of the same print.

Background Fabric – Cut 1 ¼" strips x WOF. Subcut into 1 ¼" x 3 ¼" rectangles until you have 82 Cut 1 ¼" x 2 ½" rectangles until you have 82.

NOTE: We will be using larger pieces of the background fabric in a future step.
