## CLUE 2

FOR $60 \times 60$ QUILT -

Cut the following strips from your background fabric. Cut 2 strips $133 / 8^{\prime \prime} \times$ WOF. Subcut each strip into 2 squares $133 / 8^{\prime \prime} \times 133 / 8^{\prime \prime}$ and 1 square $67 / 8 \prime$ x $67 / 8 \prime$.

Subcut each $133 / 8^{\prime \prime} \times 133 / 8^{\prime \prime}$ square into 4 triangles by cutting along both diagonal lines to yield 16 side triangles total.

Subcut each $67 / 8^{\prime \prime} \times 67 / 8^{\prime \prime}$ square into 2 triangles by cutting along one diagonal line to yield 4 corner triangles total.

FOR THE $30 \times 30$ WALL HANGING

Background fabric:

1. Cut 8 ea. $41 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ Squares and then subcut diagonally to make 16 triangles
2. Cut 2 ea. 4 " squares and then subcut diagonally to make 4 triangles

Wall Hanging: This smaller version needs a border added to make the finished size approximately 30 " square. Take this into consideration when gathering fabrics for this quilt.
