

How to Sew the Mini Stockings

Step 1

For each stocking, cut two pieces from the stocking pattern and one piece from the cuff pattern.

Step 2

With right sides together, stitch around the perimeter of the stocking with a 1/4-inch seam. Clip the curves. Turn the right side out and press.

TIP: Use a 1/4 inch foot and slow down around the curves.

With wrong sides together, fold the cuff in half lengthwise and stitch with a 1/4-inch seam. Press the seam open.

Fold the cuff in half with the wrong sides together. Press.

Step 3

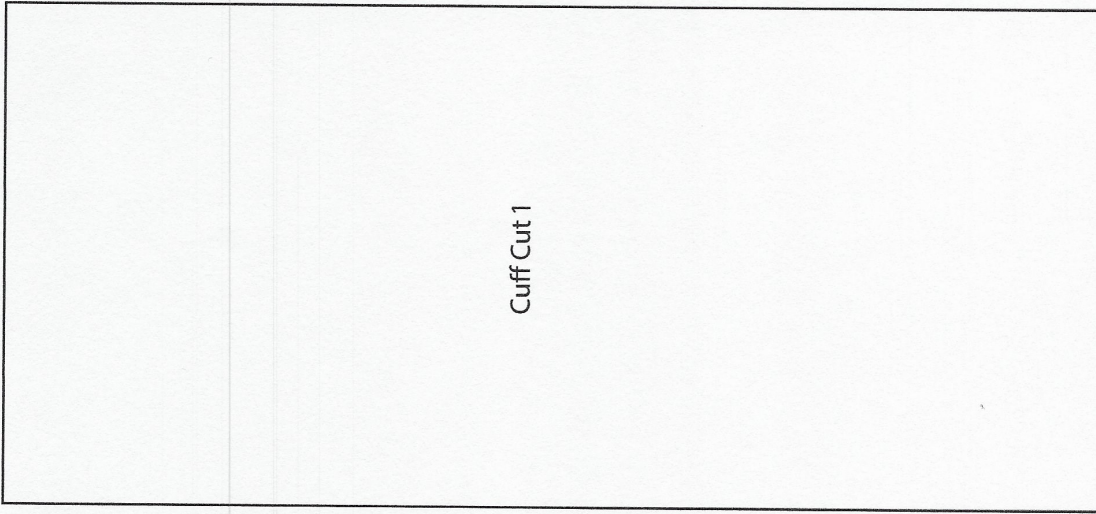
With the stocking right side out, tuck the cuff inside the stocking. You will have the cuff against the wrong side of the stocking. Stitch with a 1/4-inch seam.

Pull the cuff out of the stocking. Press the seam down then press the stocking.

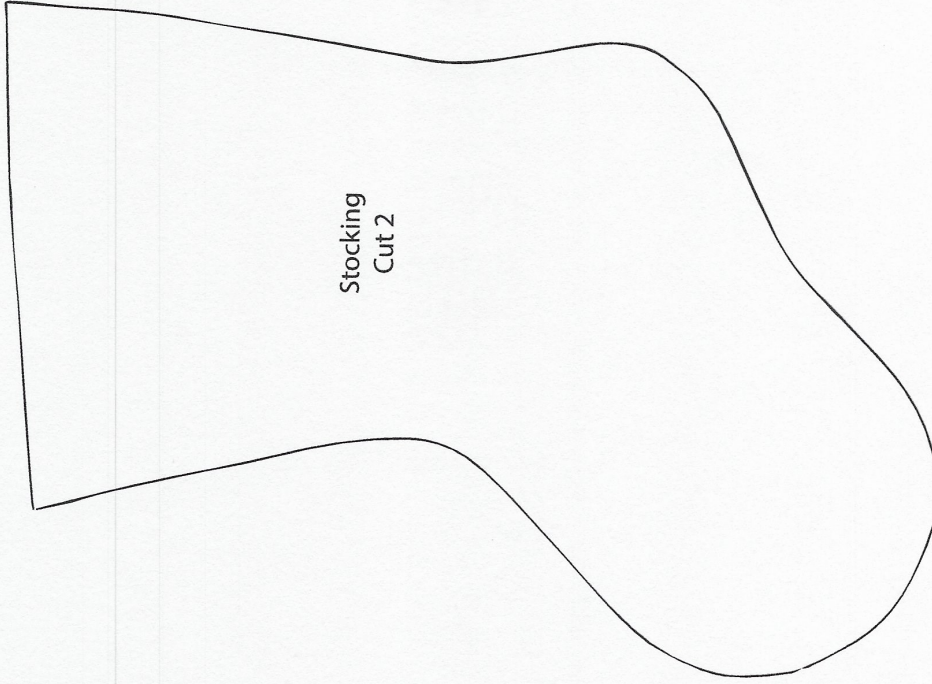
Use a mini clip to attach the stocking to the twine.

TIP: This is a very small opening. My zipper foot made stitching easier because it is shorter than my other feet so I had more control. Go slow and take just a few stitches at a time making sure the fabrics are aligned and the needle continues to stitch at 1/4 inch from the edge.
