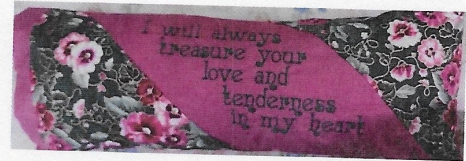




Spiral Pillow Instructions

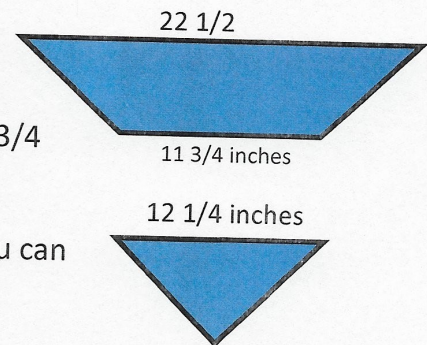
Items you will need



- Solid Fabric
- Matching Print Fabric
- Inside Pillow Fabric
- Stuffing
- Cutting Board
- 6 inch Plastic Ruler
- Rotary Cutter

Step 1. Cut 6 inch strips, on a 45% diagonal, from both solid and print. They will need to measure 36 inches. You can also cut on the grain as long as the measurements are the same. You can also cut from 2 prints that coordinate with each other.

Step 2. Cut one from both solid and print at a 45 % diagonal so that they make trapezoids. The long side is 23 inches and the short side is 12 1/4 inches. Cut triangles that they measure 12 3/4 inches on the bottom. You can also cut 2 prints that coordinate.



Step 3. Cut 2 strips form solid 16 X 1 3/4 and 16 X 2 1/2. You can Also cut from the coordinating fabric.

Step 4. Sew the long sides of the solid and print together. Sew the triangles to the other side of the trapezoids with solid to print and print to solid. Finish seams, top stitch, and trim to square. You can also use 2 prints that coordinate.



Step 5. Fold the 16 X 2 1/2 strip in half and sew to one end and sew the 16 X 1 3/4 to the other end. Finish seams and top stitch. If you are not adding embroidery skip to Step 8.



Step 6. Make 2 diagonal lines in your software at a 45% angle and being 6 inches apart. Put your lettering within these lines. They should not be more than 5 inches high.

Step 7. Center hoop on the solid area of your pillow. You do not embroider the lines they are just there for letter placement in your software.

Step 8. Sew pillow together.

Step 9. Make pillow form. Cut fabric 18 1/2 by 15 1/2. Fold in half and sew, leaving a 2 inch opening in the stitching for stuffing. Stuff and sew closed.



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
